

## **Rules ISC club site**

1. The site is only accessible to members of the ISC club and their guests.
2. If attendees are owners of an Irish setter he is welcome on this site provided that they do not sow agitation in the area. Invitees to another breed are also welcome but without dog.
3. Members with an Irish setter who also have a different breed are allowed with this dog in the field, and only under the condition that this dog brings no agitation between the setters.
4. Each dog must be vaccinated.
5. If no members of the committee are present, the instructors maintain order.
6. Board members and the instructors are entitled to ask the vaccination record for verification.
7. Every dog owner remains personally responsible for the damages caused by his dog. Insurance Policy is mandatory.
8. Each owner is required to have poo bags with them.
9. Dogshit must always be cleaned both on the way to and from the site, and on the premises.
10. It is prohibited for both people and dogs to go along the inside of the fort.
11. Dogs must be kept on leash up to the site.
12. During the opening hours of the clubhouse it is expected of each owner to have his dog under control and to monitor him and to put on the leash in case of disruptive behavior. Mutual respect is expected in relation to the terrain visitors and their dog (s).
13. Bitches in season may not be on the premises during opening hours of the clubhouse or during an activity. With the exception of the G & G exam (appointments are made by committee and instructors).
14. Bitches need to leave the area if there are other members with males wishing to enter the field on Sunday and during the week. Mutual respect is expected in relation to the terrain visitors and their dog (s).
15. The committee is not responsible for accidents or theft.
16. Parents are responsible for their children.
17. When leaving the site ensure that the gate is always closed, the last person to leave the field ensures that the door is locked. In case of damage to the terrain immediately call the responsible of the site.
